NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Nirmala Sitharaman Virtually Inaugurated India's 1st 3D Printed House

- Union Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman virtually inaugurated India's 1st 3D printed house at the Indian Institute of Technology Madras, Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- The single-storey home has been built in just five days over an area of about 600 sq. ft using 'Concrete 3D Printing'.

Mamata wins West Bengal but loses in Nandigram

- Trinamool Congress chairperson Mamata Banerjee led her party to one of its biggest political victories in the past three decades by single handedly stopping the BJP juggernaut in Bengal, with over 48% of all votes polled.
- In Nandigram, BJP's **Suvendu Adhikari defeated Mamata Banerjee** by a margin of 1,956 votes.

'Parvat Dhara Yojana'

• The State Government of Himachal Pradesh has initiated 'Parvat Dhara Yojana' to revive, recharge aquifers and conserve natural resources of water in the state. It's objective is to enhance water level by retaining water for the maximum period.

Democratic Republic of Congo declared the end of the twelfth outbreak of Ebola

- The **Democratic Republic of Congo** declared the **end of the twelfth outbreak of Ebola**. It had killed six people in the eastern province of North Kivu.
- The **Ebola virus** was discovered in 1976. The Ebola virus transmits from **wild animals to people**.

Sebi Imposed Fine on Several Entities in Vakrangee Case

- A total fine of **Rs 1.75 crore** was **imposed by Markets regulator Securities Exchange Board of India** on several entities for indulging in fraudulent trading in the scrip of **Vakrangee Ltd**.
- The entities have violated **Prohibition of Fraudulent** and **Unfair Trade Practices** norms.

T Rabi Sankar

- The Appointment Committee of the Cabinet has appointed T Rabi Sankar, the Executive Director of Reserve Bank of India as the 4th Deputy Governor of RBI.
- ACC has cleared his appointment for a period of 3 years or till his date of superannuation. He succeeds B P Kanungo.

- Justice Prafulla Chandra Pant, a Former Supreme Court Judge had been appointed as Acting Chairperson of National Human Rights Commission with effect from April 25, 2021.
- He Succeeds Justice H.L. Dattu, whose tenure ended on December 2, 2020.

Tripurari Sharan

- Senior IAS Officer Tripurari Sharan has been appointed as Chief Secretary of Bihar.
- He will serve only for a period of two months. He succeeds Arun Kumar Singh who died of Covid-19.
