NATIONAL AFFAIRS

S-400

- The Russian Government has agreed to deliver the first regimental set of S-400 Triumf SA-21 Growler Air Defence System to India.
- It is a long-range surface-to-air missile system. The system has the capability to form an impenetrable grid of missiles.

Transfer of technology- COVID vaccine

- The Government of India approved the transfer of technology from **Bharat Biotech to Hafkine Institute**.
- **COVAXIN** is one of the two drugs that is currently administered in India. It is manufactured by **Bharat** Biotech in collaboration with the Indian Council of Medical Research.

PM CARES Fund

- The Ministry of Health announced that around hundred new hospitals are to have their own oxygen plant under the PM CARES Fund.
- PM CARES Fund is Prime Minister's Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations Fund.

Agriculture Ministry, Microsoft India Joined hands to enhance the Farmers income

- Ministry of Agriculture signed a MoU with Microsoft India to undertake a Pilot Project in 100 villages in 6 states.
- The pilot programme is aimed at **reducing input cost** and boosting the income of Farmers. For the implementation of the project, Microsoft India has partnered with a local partner 'CropData Technologies'.

INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

"My Body is My Own"

- The **United Nations Population Fund** recently released a report "My Body is My Own".
- The report is about women's power to make decisions on their bodies. It also reported about the laws in different countries that support women rights in this matter.

United Nations Food Systems Summit

The United Nations General Secretary called for the first United Nations Food Systems Summit to be held in September 2021.

Inclusive Internet Index

- The Economist Intelligence Unit along with Facebook released the Inclusive Internet Index.
- According to the index, **India** is at the **49**th **spot** when it comes to internet inclusion and gender equality in accessing the internet. The Facebook Inclusive Internet Index looked at 120 countries.

Adenovirus

- The US health authorities paused the rollout of oneshot Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.
- The vaccine uses similar technology as that of the Astra Zeneca vaccine. Both the vaccines are developed from adenoviral vectors.

BUSINESS & ECONOMY

Regional Economic Outlook

- The International Monetary Fund released the Regional Economic Outlook for Sub Saharan Africa.
- According to the report the Sub Saharan region is to witness the world's slowest growth in 2021. The region is projected to grow by 3.4% in 2021.

ENVIRONMENT & GEOGRAPHY

Normal monsoon in India

- The Indian Meteorological Department announced that the southwest monsoon is expected to be normal at 98% of the Long Period Average.
- This is mainly because the La Nina or El Nino weather conditions that affect monsoon rains in India are likely to be **absent**.

Forest fires

- Uttarakhand recorded 361 forest fire incidents in just five days. During this period, over 567 hectares of forests have been destroyed.
- Every year forest fires begin in mid-February in the state of Uttarakhand. The three main factors that cause forest fires are oxygen, fuel load and temperature. The dry leaves are the main fuel for the forest fires.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

ISRO signed an agreement France

- The Indian Space Research Organisation signed an agreement with the French Space Agency CNES.
- CNES stands for **Centre National d'etudes Spatiales.** According to the agreement, CNES is to help India in its first Human Space Mission called the Gaganyaan.

SpaceX Crew 2

- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration is to launch four astronauts to the International Space Station on World Earth Day (April 22).
- NASA is to launch the mission along with **SpaceX.** It is the second crewed operational flight of Crew Dragon Spacecraft.

PM Narendra Modi Released 4 books on Life of BR **Ambedkar**

- PM Narendra Modi virtually released 4 books based on Ambedkar's life, which were authored by Kishor Makwana.
- The books were Dr. Ambedkar Jivan Darshan, Dr. Ambedkar Vyakti Darshan, Dr Ambedkar Rashtra Darshan, and Dr. Ambedkar Aayam Darshan.

Balbir Singh

- Former Indian Hockey legend Balbir Singh Junior passed away at the age of 88 due to heart failure in Chandigarh.
- He was a member of the Indian Hockey team which won silver medal at the 1958 Asian games. He is popularly considered as the nursery of Hockey players in India.
