# NATIONAL AFFAIRS

### SII fixes price for Covishield

- The Serum Institute of India will sell its COVID19 vaccine, 'Covishield', to the States at Rs.400 a dose and to private hospitals at Rs.600 a dose, its chief executive officer, Adar Poonawala, said in a statement.
- The vaccines, however, would not be sold in retail for four or five months, and corporates and private individuals.

#### World Cities Cultural Forum 2021

- Arvind Kejriwal, Chief Minister of Delhi will be representing Delhi and India at the World Cities Cultural Forum (WCCF) 2021.
- The Forum comprises 40 world cities including London, Tokyo and New York. The WCCF 2021 Forum was hosted by London.

### **Cycling policy**

Chandigarh has released a first of its kind draft cycling policy, this is the first time for a city to draft a cycling policy in India.

• The draft recognises cycling as one of the environment friendly and quickest modes of transport in urban areas. The policy was drafted by the Chandigarh Smart City Limited.

# INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

#### Press freedom index

- The World Press Freedom Index, 2021, produced by Reporters Without Borders, a French non governmental organisation, has again ranked India at 142nd out of 180 countries.
- In 2016, India's rank was 133, which has steadily climbed down to 142 in 2020.

### **Global Energy Review report**

- The International Energy Agency released the Global **Energy Review report.** According to the report, the Carbon Dioxide emissions in India is to be 1.4% higher than the levels recorded in 2019.
- The carbon dioxide emissions all over the world is to increase by 1.5 billion tonnes in 2021.

#### **Global Energy Transition Index**

- The World Economic Forum recently the Global Energy Transition Index. The index was prepared in collaboration with Accenture.
- **Sweden ranked first** in the report followed by Norway and Denmark. India ranked 87th in the index.

### "Countries of Particular Concern"

- The US Commission for International Religious Freedom recommended Biden Administration to place four countries including India under "Countries of Particular Concern".
- The other three countries were Russia, Vietnam and Syria.

### **Nimbus Project**

- The Government of Israel has chosen Google and **Amazon Web Services** to provide cloud services for its military and Public Sector Units.
- The project is to be implemented in four phases and has been named the "Nimbus" project. It will establish cloud sites in Israel.

# BUSINESS & ECONOMY

#### FirstRand Bank

- FirstRand Bank, the second largest bank in South Africa has decided to withdraw its **banking services** from India just within a week of Citi banks exit.
- FirstRand had started its banking service in India in late 2009. The bank has its only office in Mumbai.

### **IOB** appoints Ernst & Young as its Digital Consultant

- Indian Overseas Bank appointed Ernst & Young **Global Limited**, a multinational professional services network as its **digital consultant**.
- This partnership is a part of IOB's growth strategy to transform its banking services into **Digital format**.

### Care Ratings Revised down India's GDP Growth Forecast

- Care Ratings has reduced India's Gross Domestic Product growth forecast for FY 22 to 10.2 per cent from its earlier projection of 10.7-10.9 per cent.
- In the last 30 days, this is the third revision by the rating agency due to the surge in COVID-19 cases and local restrictions.

### South Korea's LG Electronics closes down mobile phone business

- South Korea's LG Electronics has announced that it is closing down its mobile phone business unit worldwide after nearly six years of losses totalling \$4.5 billion.
- The decision was approved by its board of directors.

- The **IIT Kharagpur** has successfully commercialised the healthcare product COVIRAP.
- COVIRAP is a diagnostic technology to detect COVID-19 virus. The technology is also capable of testing influenza, dengue, malaria. Tuberculosis and Japanese Encephalitis.
