Asia's Largest Fulfillment Center

- Haryana state govt. has approved allotment of 140 acres of land for e-commerce major, Flipkart for setting-up asia's largest fulfillment center in Gurugram, Haryana.
- The centres will be equipped with highly automated pick, pack, and shipping processes to facilitate safe and timely processing of orders.

"Mask Abhiyan"

- The Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik launched a fourteen day "Mask Abhiyan" initiative to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- It's objective is to turn the use of mask into a habit. This will play a huge role in controlling the current resurgence of COVID-19.

Meghalaya villagers oppose dam on Umngot

Stiff resistance from at least 12 villages in Meghalaya has cast a cloud on a 210 MW hydroelectric project on Umngot, considered India's clearest river.

• The project documents say people of 13 villages along the Umngot are likely to lose 296 hectares of land due to submergence if the dam comes up.

- Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation, a civic body in Uttar Pradesh, has become **India's first municipal** corporation to issue municipal green bonds.
- Funds of these green bonds will be used for the construction of a tertiary sewage treatment plant to benefit industries in Ghaziabad.

Dolphin upturn in Odisha's Chilika lake

- The population of dolphins in Chilika, India's largest brackish water lake, and along the Odisha coast has doubled this year compared with last year.
- Three species were recorded during the census, with 544 Irrawaddy, bottle nose and humpback dolphins sighted this year, compared with 233 last year.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

A dozen quasars discovered

- Astronomers have discovered a dozen quasars that have been warped by a naturally occurring cosmic "lens" and split into four similar images.
- Quasars are extremely luminous cores of distant galaxies that are powered by supermassive black holes.
