NATIONAL

1) Asia Pacific Telecommunity

- The Asia Pacific Telecommunity is set to be held in Brisbane. It aims to determine the future deployment of the 6 GHz spectrum band for 5G services in India.
- As India and other Region 3 member nations, including China, South Korea, Japan, and others, prepare for the World Radio Communications-2023 conference in Dubai, the decisions made in this meeting will play a crucial role in shaping the 5G landscape in the country.
- The meeting's main purpose is to deliberate and finalize the deployment of the 6 GHz spectrum band for 5G services in India.

2) 'Moving Mental Health Beyond Institutions'

- The National Conference on 'Moving Mental Health Beyond Institutions' aiming to primarily address the implementation challenges encountered during the execution of the Mental Healthcare Act. 2017.
- The conference is designed to have four thematic sessions covering various aspects of mental health, including infrastructural and human resource challenges in mental health establishments, rights of persons with mental illness, and the latest trends in critical care of mental health with an international perspective.

3) 'Mera Gaon Meri Dharohar'

Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated a significant initiative known as 'Mera Gaon Meri Dharohar'. It is a pan-India project spearheaded by the Ministry of Culture under the National Mission on Cultural Mapping.

4) Bharat Mandapam

- Bengaluru has become the first Indian city to join the World Cities Culture Forum. It is an organization founded in 2012 by the office of the Mayor of London.
- The city's inclusion was attributed to its dedication to an inclusive and globalized culture.

1) Intelligent Traffic Management System

- Mysuru city is set to introduce Intelligent Traffic Management System, equipped with AI-powered cameras at 25 locations.
- The system will automatically capture violations such as helmetless riding, tripleriding on two-wheelers, driver-on-call, seat belt violation, and signal jump.

1) India will become the third largest economy by FY28 - SBI Research

- According to SBI Research economists, India will become the third largest economy by FY28. India will likely grow 8.1% in the first quarter of FY24, pushing the overall growth rate to 6.5%.
