INTERNATIONAL

1) Shanghai Cooperation Organisation

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to attend Shanghai Cooperation Organisation summit, to be held in Samarkand, Uzbekistan.
- This will be the first in-person summit after June 2019 when the SCO summit was held in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.
- The Shanghai Cooperation Organisation is a permanent intergovernmental international organisation, created on 15 June 2001 in Shanghai (China).

2) North Korea passes law regarding Nuclear Strikes

- North Korea has approved a law that gives it the authority to launch a nuclear attack in advance.
- With the recently passed law, North Korea's status as a nuclear weapons state has become irreversible.

NATIONAL

1) Nikshay 2.0 portal

- The president of India, Draupadi Murmu launched the 'Pradhan Mantri TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyan' and the Nikshay 2.0 portal to eliminate TB by 2025 through a virtual event.
- Under this campaign, any person, any representative or organization can adopt TB patients and the adopted patients will be taken care of.
- The people and institutions who come forward to take care of the patients will be called "Nikshay Mitras".

2) 'Taragiri' - stealth frigate

- 'Taragiri', the third stealth frigate of the Indian Navy's Project 17A, was launched in Mumbai. The vessel is being launched with an approximate launch weight of 3,510 tons.
- The frigate is designed by the Indian Navy's in-house design organization, the Bureau of Naval Design.

3) 'Gagan Strike' by Defence forces

- Indian Army's Kharga Corps and the Indian Air Force have conducted a joint

OBITUARY

1) Justice Kamal Narain Singh

- Former Chief Justice of India Kamal Narain Singh passed away, at the age of 95.
- He had a tenure a tenure of only 17 days as the CJI, making him the chief justice with the shortest tenure. He was the 22nd Chief Justice of India, with a term from November 25, 1991, to December 12, 1991.

BOOKS & AUTHORS

1) "Crimson Spring"

- The book, Crimson Spring, written by Navtej Sarna, longlisted for the JCB Prize for Literature, starts with the Jalianwalla Bagh massacre that took place on April 13, 1919, and goes back and forth in time to bring that era and the aftermath of the event alive.

1) International Day for South-South Cooperation

- The International Day for South-South Cooperation is observed on September 12, every year by the United Nations.
- It is an initiative for the economic, social and political developments of the countries located in Southern region.

2) National Forest Martyrs Day
