#### Lewis Hamilton wins 2021 Bahrain Grand Prix

- Mercedes driver Lewis Hamilton won the 2021 **Bahrain Grand Prix**
- The **defending seven-time champion** defended with supreme skill over the closing laps in his Mercedes to hold off the Red Bull driver, Max Verstappen, and claim a record-stretching 96th Formula One victory.

## Nine cities in Australia and New Zealand to host 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup

- The 2023 Women's World Cup of football will be spread across nine cities in Australia and New Zealand.
- The opening match will take place at Eden Park in Auckland, with Sydney's Stadium Australia hosting the final.

## Indian Skipper Virat Kohli retained the top spot in ICC ODI rankings

- Team India captain Virat Kohli had retained his top spot in the ICC rankings for ODI batsmen.
- Kohli has 870 points in his kitty. KL Rahul has moved up from 31st to 27th, Hardik Pandya has achieved a career-best 42nd position while Rishabh Pant has entered the top 100.
