#### 1) Smog towers

- Smog towers are not final solution to pollution, as per statement released by the Central Pollution Control Board. Smog is dirty brown haze that hangs over skylines of major cities.

- Smog towers are structures designed as large-scale air purifiers to reduce air pollution.

- India's first 'smog tower' is in Connaught Place, Delhi. China has world's largest smog tower (60-metre high).

# 2) E- band

Broadband, tech and WiFi players opposes to give E band exclusively to Telcos.
The waveguide E band is the range of radio frequencies from 60 GHz to 90 GHz in the electromagnetic spectrum. E-band is a major solution of 5G's microwave transmission.

# 3) Shigella bacteria

- Kerala seeks to contain Shigella spread. Shigella is a genus of bacteria that causes an infection called shigellosis.

- Shigellosis is a gastrointestinal infection caused by one of four species of Shigella bacteria, including S. sonnei.

- It is second leading cause of bacterial diarrhea worldwide and third leading cause of death in children less than 5 years old.
