INTERNATIONAL

1) Digital Nomad Visa

- Indonesia has announced Digital Nomad Visa for travellers, to attract more foreign tourists. It would allow remote workers to stay tax-free.
- Digital Nomads are people who work remotely while travelling to different places and spending their earned income in the country they are travelling to.

2) POP-FAME

- US Scientists have developed a fuel named POP-FAME from bacteria.
- POP-FAME, i.e. polycyclopropanated fatty acid methyl ester, is a new fuel molecule made up of seven sets of cyclopropane rings.
- Cyclopropane is naturally produced by bacteria in a family called Streptomyces.

NATIONAL

1) Red pandas

- Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park (West Bengal) has started a programme to release 20 red pandas in about five years to the forests.
- Red pandas are shy, solitary and arboreal (spending life on trees) animals and considered an indicator species for ecological change. They feed mainly on bamboo.

2) Swami Atmasthananda

- PM paid his tributes to Swami Atmasthananda on his birth centenary.
- He was the 15th President of the Ramakrishna Math and the Ramakrishna Mission.
- Ramakrishna Mission was founded by Swami Vivekananda (1897) to propagate the teachings of Vedanta as embodied by Ramakrishna Paramahansa.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Rajeev Chandrasekhar

- Rajeev Chandrasekhar, inaugurated two new Internet Exchange Points (IXP) of National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI) at Durgapur and Vardhman.
- The National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI) also manages the first Internet Exchange in the state of Kolkata.

APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Alvaro Lario

- The governing council of the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) has been appointed as Spain's Alvaro Lario new President.
- Lario will take office on 1 October 2022 and serve a four-year term. He will succeed Gilbert Houngbo who has led the organisation since 2017.

2) Ranil Wickremesinghe

- Ranil Wickremesinghe has resigned as Sri Lankan prime minister to make way for an all-party government to take over.
- He will resign after an all-party government is established and the majority is secured in Parliament.

SPORTS

1) Wimbledon men's title

- Serbia Novak Djokovic won a seventh Wimbledon men's title and 21st Grand Slam crown with a four-set triumph over Nick Kyrgios.
- Kyrgios gave his best to challenge the more experienced rival in his first Major final, but he could take only one set, propelling Djokovic toward the 21st Major crown.

- National Fish Farmers Day is celebrated on 10th July every year to demonstrate solidarity with all fisher folk, fish farmers and concerned stakeholders throughout the Country.
