### 1) Global Findex database

- World Bank releases Global Findex database. Global Findex database surveyed how people in 123 economies use formal and informal financial services including use of cards, mobile phones, and internet to make and receive digital payment throughout 2021.
- According to the report, India is among seven countries home to half the world's 1.4 billion adults without access to formal banking.

## 1) Digital India Week 2022

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated Digital India Week 2022 at Mahatma Mandir in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- The theme of this Digital India Week is 'Catalyzing New India's Techade' to transform the nation into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

# 2) National Food Security Act

- Odisha has topped in the state ranking for implementation of the National Food Security Act (NFSA) through ration shops, followed by Uttar Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh.
- Union Food and Consumer Affairs Minister Piyush Goyal released the 'State Ranking Index for NFSA' 2022.
- Odisha is at first position with a score of 0.836, followed by Uttar Pradesh (0.797) and Andhra Pradesh (0.794).

- The CBSE Board has launched a portal called 'Pariksha Sangam' to streamline board examination results, sample papers, and other details in one single window.

- Russian Rosatom State Corporation has signed an agreement with India's Atomic power operator, Nuclear Corporation of India Ltd to supply thermocouples for four power units of Kudankulam Nuclear Power Plant (KNPP) in Tamil Nadu.
- Thermocouples are primary temperature measuring transducers designed to measure the temperature of the nuclear reactor coolant.
