1) 8th Global Pharmaceutical Quality Summit 2023

- The 8th Global Pharmaceutical Quality Summit 2023 held in Mumbai. The meeting was attended by Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Chemicals and Fertilisers and Health & Family Welfare.
- The theme of the meeting was "Patient Centricity: New Paradigm of Manufacturing and Quality."

2) India - U.S. strategic Partnership

- Recently, the Indian Prime Minister was on a significant visit to USA.
- The visit aimed to strengthen the strategic partnership between the two countries and focused on addressing common challenges, taking a stand on global issues, collaborating in many areas.
- Strengthening Semiconductor Supply Chains
- India and the US have established public-private Joint Task Forces on the development and deployment of Open RAN systems and advanced telecoms research and development.
- India has signed the Artemis Accords, joining 26 other countries committed to peaceful, sustainable, and transparent cooperation for space exploration.

2) ASEAN - joint military exercise

- ASEAN to hold a inaugural military exercise in South China Sea. The decision was made during a meeting of military commanders from the 10-member Association of Southeast Asian Nations in Indonesia.

- It aims to promote unity and cooperation among ASEAN member states, highlighting their collective strength and presence in the region.
