NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Mid-day Meal Scheme

- The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education has recommended that all government schools start providing free breakfast in the coming academic year.
- The National Education Policy identifies "providing food and nutrition" as one of the key long-term thrust areas. The Midday meal scheme was launched in 1995.

Floating Solar Power Plant

- India's biggest floating solar power plant by generation capacity is being developed by the National Thermal Power Corporation Limited at Ramagundam of Telangana.
- Floating Solar Power Plant refers to the deployment of photovoltaic panels on the surface of water bodies.

"Mera Ration Mobile App"

- The central government has launched the "Mera Ration Mobile App".
- This app was launched in order to facilitate the 'One Nation-One Ration Card' system. The app was developed by the National Informatics Centre.

'Dandi March'

- The **Prime Minister** has flagged off a **commemorative 'Dandi March'** (on 12th March) to launch the celebrations of the 75th year of Independence - 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsay'.
- The Dandi March, also known as the Salt March and the Dandi Satyagraha was an act of nonviolent civil disobedience led by Gandhi.

PRoject Information System & Management

- The **Science and Engineering Board** has set up a portal called PRoject Information System & Management (PRISM) that offers real time information on the various research projects supported by it.
- The portal is expected to work as a comprehensive tool to help forge stronger scientist-scientist, and science-society connections.

14th five-year plan

- China has formally approved its 14th five-year plan for 2021-2025.

- India has been classified as an "electoral autocracy" in the annual report named Autocratisation Goes Viral of Sweden-based Varieties of Democracy (V-Dem) Institute.
- India was previously classified as an electoral democracy, however the latest report classified it as electoral autocracy.

BRICS Contact Group on Economic and Trade Issues

- The BRICS Contact Group on Economic and Trade **Issues** held their **first meeting** under the Chair ship of India.
- The meeting was held under the Theme -"BRICS @15: Intra **BRICS** Cooperation for Continuity, Consolidation, and Consensus".

Bamiyan Buddhas

- Bamiyan Buddhas were brought back to life with the help of 3D projection in the event held in the Bamiyan Valley of Afghanistan.
- The event called "A Night with Buddha" was held on the **anniversary of annihilation**. Bamiyan Buddhas were two 6th-century monumental statues of Gautama Buddha.

"LGBTIQ Freedom Zone"

- The **European Parliament** has declared whole of the European Union as "LGBTIQ Freedom Zone".
- This symbolic resolution was passed in the answer to local authorities in Poland who were labeling themselves as "LGBT ideology-free zones".

"Soundbox 2.0"

- Paytm, launched "Smart PoS" a new application for accepting contactless payments through smartphones.
- Paytm also launched the second version of its **Internet of Things** based instant voice conformation device, "Soundbox 2.0".

Mt. Sinabung

- Mt. Sinabung, an active volcano on Indonesia's Sumatra island has erupted.
- Mt. Sinabung (2,600-metre) is located in Karo regency, North Sumatra. The volcano was dormant for 400 years before exploding in 2010.

BBC Indian Sportswoman of the year

- Koneru Humpy, chess player won the 2nd edition of the BBC Indian Sportswoman of the year.
