Raisina Dialogue

- The Raisina Dialogue was organised by the Ministry of External Affairs and Observer Research Foundation.
- The dialogue was held under the theme: viral World: Outbreaks, Outliers and Out of Control. It was held for the first time in 2016.

Ambedkar Jayanti

- Every year India celebrates Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti on April 14. The day is also called Ambedkar Remembrance Day.
- He struggled for **equality** throughout his life. Thus, his birthday is also celebrated as "Equality Day". In 1956, he converted to Buddhism.

Poshan Gyan

- NITI Aayog launched Poshan Gyan along with the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and the Centre for Social and Behaviour Change, Ashoka University.
- Poshan Gyan is a National Digital Repository on health and nutrition.

Infant Toddler and Caregiver friendly Neighbourhoods Training

- The National Institute of Urban Affairs launched the Infant Toddler and Caregiver friendly Neighbourhoods Training and Capacity Building Programme.
- It is designed to build capacities of young professionals and city officials to develop young children and family friendly neighbourhoods in the country.

STATE AFFAIRS

Maharashtra imposes 'mini lockdown'

- Maharashtra Chief Minister **Uddhav Thackeray** announced a "mini lockdown" in the State for 15 days from 8 p.m.
- According to the guidelines announced by the State government, Section 144 would be imposed for 15 days and no one would be allowed to move in public places without valid reason.

INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

WHO urges halt on sale of live wild mammals in markets

- The World Health Organization called for a halt to the sale of live wild mammals in food markets to prevent the emergence of new diseases such as COVID19.
- The agencies recalled that some of the earliest known cases of COVID19 had links to a wholesale food market in Wuhan.

BUSINESS & ECONOMY

Currency Chests

- A private security guard has looted Rs 4.04 crores from the currency chest of Axis Bank in Chandigarh.
- Currency Chests are places where RBI stocks money meant for banks and ATMs. The Currency Chests are located in different banks and are administered by the Reserve Bank of India.

Hallmarking of gold

- The Government of India announced that it is fully prepared to implement mandatory hallmarking of gold artefacts and jewellery from June 1, 2021.
- Gold Hallmarking is providing purity certification to the gold jewellery and artefacts.

"Special Refinance Facility"

- The National Housing Bank launched the "Special Refinance Facility", 2021. Rs 10,00 crores has been allocated to this facility.
- The main objective of the facility is to provide short term refinance support to the housing finance companies and other eligible Primary Lending Institutions.

Pine Labs acquires Fave in \$45mn deal

- Merchant commerce solutions provider Pine Labs said it has acquired consumer fintech platform Fave in a deal valued at more than \$45 million, as part of its expansion plans.
- Fave's investors will receive an all cash payout, while founders and key Fave employees will receive both cash and Pine Labs shares.

ENVIRONMENT & GEOGRAPHY

Bohag Bihu Bird count

- The Bohag Bihu Bird count began in Assam. It was launched by Bird Count of India.
- The BCI is a **Non- Governmental Organisation**. This is the first time BCI is launching Bohag Bihu bird count. Bohag Bihu is also called **Xaat Bihu**. It is the traditional ethnic festival celebrated in Assam.

Skymet forecasts a 'healthy normal' monsoon

- **Skymet Weather**, a private weather forecast company, said that the monsoon was likely to be 103% of the long period average this year.
- The LPA refers to the average all **India monsoon** rainfall of 88 cm, which is a 50 year mean.
