1) Argentine President Javier Milei has officially declined the invitation

- Argentine President Javier Milei has officially declined the invitation to join the BRICS (Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa) of major emerging economies.
- The rejection was conveyed through letters sent to BRICS leaders, solidifying Argentina's decision to abstain from the bloc.

1) ONGC Petro additions Limited

APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Vice President of India, Jagdeep Dhankhar

The Vice President of India, Jagdeep Dhankhar, has been appointed as the ex-officio Chancellor of Pondicherry University. This appointment comes as a result of a modification in Statute 1(1) of the Pondicherry University Act of 1985.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) November Month Growth Rate

- In November, the production growth of eight crucial infrastructure sectors hit a sixmonth low at 7.8%, primarily attributed to declines in the crude oil and cement sectors. While this figure is higher than the 5.7% recorded a year ago, it reflects a slowdown from October's 12% growth.
- The last comparable dip occurred in May, with a growth rate of 5.2%. Despite the overall deceleration, coal and refinery product outputs demonstrated double-digit growth.

2) Personal income and corporate tax collections in India

In the span of 10 years under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership, both personal income and corporate tax collections in India are expected to surge to over Rs 19 trillion.

This substantial growth provides the government with flexibility to introduce tax measures benefiting the public.
