INTERNATIONAL

1) Artificial Light to Fight Against Malaria

- A study demonstrated that artificial lights can be used as a weapon to fight against malaria.

- Light plays a crucial role in the regulation of biological clocks such as timing of breeding among birds, hunting by lions and sleeping patterns of humans.

- Malaria is a life-threatening mosquito borne blood disease caused by plasmodium parasites.

NATIONAL

1) Fishing Cats

- According to a census conducted by Chilika Development Authority, the Chilika Lake has 176 Fishing Cats.

- It's Scientific Name is Prionailurus viverrinus. Fishing cats have a patchy distribution along the Eastern Ghats.

- Apart from Sundarbans in West Bengal and Bangladesh, fishing cats inhabit the Chilika lagoon and surrounding wetlands in Odisha, Coringa and Krishna mangroves in Andhra Pradesh

2) "My Pad My Right programme"

- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development, Chairman Dr GR Chintala has launched "My Pad My Right programme", in Leh.

- The programme launched by Nabard's NabFoundation with machinery and materials of a cost of Seven and half Lakh rupees.

- This efforts are on for economic empowerment of rural women through menstrual hygiene.

3) Ex SAMPRITI-X

India-Bangladesh bilateral defence cooperation, a joint military training exercise Ex SAMPRITI-X is being conducted at Jashore Military Station in Bangladesh.

1) Luxury cruise liner "Empress"

- The packages include going to the high seas from the city port and to return, and also to anchor at Puducherry and Visakhapatnam harbours, as said by the operator.
