## NATIONAL

### 1) Raisina Dialogue 2022

- Raisina Dialogue is a multilateral conference committed to addressing the most challenging issues facing the global community. It takes its name from Raisina Hill- the seat of the Indian government.
- It held annually in New Delhi since 2016. It is hosted by the Observer Research Foundation
- It has emerged as India's flagship conference on geopolitics and geo-economics.

### 2) PLI Scheme for White Goods

- The objective of the scheme is to create complete component ecosystem in India and make India an integral part of global supply chains.
- The white goods industry consists of air conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines and dryers, dishwashers, and LED Lights.
- The scheme offers an incentive of 4-6% on incremental sales of goods manufactured in India.

### 3) Canine Distemper

- The Gujarat Biotechnology Research Centre has developed and completed the first trials of the Canine Distemper Virus (CDV) vaccine for the Asiatic lion.
- Canine distemper is caused by the paramyxovirus virus and it spreads through body fluids like infected urine, blood and saliva.
- The virus attacks the respiratory, gastrointestinal and nervous systems.

### 4) Megalithic Period Cave

- A rock-cut cave from Megalithic period (800 BC to 500 BC) has been found at Kadaba taluk in Dakshina Kannada, Karnataka.
- Megalith is a large stone used to construct a monument or a structure. Megaliths were constructed either as burial sites or commemorative memorials.
- Megaliths are spread across the Indian subcontinent, though bulk of them are concentrated in Peninsular India.
