INTERNATIONAL

1) "The World Together"

WHO is discussing Pandemic Treaty in the backdrop of COVID 19 pandemic exposing the cracks in the global health system. In December 2021, World Health Assembly (WHA) adopted a decision titled "The World Together" at its second special session since it was founded in 1948.

2) Montreux Convention

Turkey pledged to implement 1936 Montreux Convention Regarding the Regime of the Straits to limit the movement of Russian warships between Mediterranean Sea and Black Sea. According to the convention, Turkey has control over both the Bosphorus and Dardanelles straits.

3) Facility for Low Carbon Technology Deployment

FLCTD is a project financed by the Global Environment Facility, implemented by United Nations Industrial Development Organisation in collaboration with Bureau of Energy Efficiency. FLCTD was launched in 2016 with an objective to identify innovative energy efficiency and low carbon technology solutions.

NATIONAL

1) SIMBA an Artificial Intelligence -based photo-identification software

Gujarat forest department will use SIMBA an Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based photo identification software- specifically designed to distinguish patterns or marks. Asiatic lions have unique whisker spots on either side of their muzzle. According to scientific studies, these precise patterns are highly variable and do not change over time.

2) National Commission for Protection of Child Rights

On 17th Foundation Day of NCPCR, Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD) launched the new motto of NCPCR- protect the future (children). Child is defined as a person in the 0 to 18 years age group. It monitors the implementation of POCSO Act.

3) Konark Temple

Odisha is planning to make Konark Temple and Konark town a 100 per cent solar town. Dedicated to Sun God, the temple is located on the shores of the Bay of Bengal. It was built by King Narasimha Deva I of the Eastern Ganga dynasty from 1238-1250 CE. It is a Kalinga architectural style temple.

1) Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication

Canada, U.S.A. and their European allies have come to a conclusion to remove the key Russian banks from the Interbank messaging system of SWIFT. This is a very big step that will cut off the country from much of the worldwide financial system. SWIFT (Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication) will mean that the Russian banks will not be able to communicate securely with foreign banks.
