INTERNATIONAL

- 1) Same Sex Marriage
- The Constitution of Nepal, adopted in 2015, took a bold step by explicitly prohibiting discrimination based on sexual orientation. Nepal became the first South Asian country to formally register a case of same-sex marriage.
- This event occurred in the Dordi Rural Municipality of Lamjung district in Western Nepal, where the union of trans-woman Maya Gurung, 35, and gay man Surendra Pandey, 27, was legally recognized.

NATIONAL

- 1) Anganwadi Protocol Divyang Children
- The Union Minister for Women and Child Development and Minority Affairs, Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani, recently launched the Anganwadi Protocol Divyang Children in a national outreach program at Vigyan Bhawan on November 28, 2023.
- 2) Winter Session of the Parliament
- The upcoming Winter Session of the Parliament is poised to witness significant legislative activity, with the Narendra Modi government planning to introduce seven new Bills alongside addressing 11 pending bills.
- 3) Siemens AG from Germany and Kyosan Electric Manufacturing Co
- The Indian government has granted approval to two multinational corporations, Siemens AG from Germany and Kyosan Electric Manufacturing Co from Japan, to deploy the automatic train collision avoidance system known as Kavach on the Indian Railways.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Adani Power Ltd

Adani Power Ltd (APL) has announced its pioneering green ammonia combustion pilot project at the Mundra power plant in Gujarat. This initiative aligns with APL's commitment to adopting sustainable practices and reducing its carbon footprint.

2) Second quarter of FY24

- The second quarter of FY24 witnessed a historic surge in women's labor force participation, reaching an all-time high of 24%, according to official data.
- While this is a positive development, deeper analysis reveals nuances in the employment landscape for women.

3) Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board

- The Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board (FRTIB), a major U.S. pension fund with assets surpassing \$600 billion, is poised to bring substantial investments to Indian equity markets.
- The FRTIB's decision to transition from the MSCI EAFE index to the MSCI ACWI IMI ex USA ex China ex Hong index is expected to trigger a massive \$28 billion global equity reshuffling, with India emerging as a key beneficiary.

4) Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development

The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has revised its growth projections for India, anticipating a further slowdown in the coming fiscal years.

The Indian economy is expected to grow at 6.3% in FY24, slightly under the 6.7% growth seen in Q2FY24. However, the outlook for FY25 is even more conservative,

with a projected growth of 6.1%.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

1) Kavach, to 4G/5G (LTE-based) technology

- Railways Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw announced the Ministry of Railways' plans to upgrade its indigenous anti-collision system, Kavach, to 4G/5G (LTE-based) technology.
- Kavach, developed indigenously, has been deployed across more than 1,465 route kilometres (rkm), with ongoing work for an additional 3,000 rkm.

- Every year on November 30, the world solemnly observes the Day of Remembrance for All Victims of Chemical Warfare.

1) Henry Kissinger has passed away

Henry Kissinger, a towering figure in American foreign policy, passed away on November 29, 2023, at the age of 100.

He served as the United States Secretary of State under Presidents Richard Nixon and Gerald Ford, and played a pivotal role in shaping US foreign policy during the 1970s.
