INTERNATIONAL

1) Blue transformation - Road Map 2022-2030

- Blue transformation Road Map 2022-2030 recognizes importance of aquatic food systems as drivers of employment, economic growth, social development and environmental recovery.
- It aligns with 2021 Declaration for Sustainable Fisheries and Aquaculture of Committee on Fisheries.

2) Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries

- OPEC+, have decided to cut crude oil production from October 2022. OPEC was founded in 1960 in Baghdad (Iraq) by five countries namely Iran, Iraq, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia and Venezuela.
- At present, the organisation has a total of 13 member countries with Algeria, Angola, Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Libya, Nigeria, UAE as other members. It's headquarters: Vienna.

NATIONAL

1) Pradhan Mantri Schools For Rising India

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced a new initiative, the development and upgradation of 14 thousand 500 schools across the country under the Pradhan Mantri Schools For Rising India Yojana.
- PM-SHRI schools will become model schools which will encapsulate the full spirit of the National Education Policy.
- They will be equipped with modern infra, including labs, smart classrooms, libraries, sports equipment etc.
- They will also be developed as green schools with water conservation and waste recycling provision.

2) Daspara village of Tripura -first modified bio-village

- Tripura becomes the first state in India to have the first modified bio-village.
- The Daspara village of Tripura is converted into a nature-based lifestyle and livelihood and reduced the use of chemical fertilizers.
- Daspara is one of the five successful bio-village 2.0 conceptualized in Tripura after the BJP came into power.

1) e-governance portal "Samarth"

- The Uttarakhand education department launched an e-governance portal "Samarth".
- This portal provides all administrative and educational updates including information about entrance exams, salary structures, and appointments from five state universities and 140 public schools.

APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Justice DY Chandrachud

- Supreme Court judge Justice DY Chandrachud has been appointed as the next executive chairperson of the National Legal Services Authority (NALSA).
- The post was previously held by the Chief Justice of India UU Lalit.
- President Droupadi Murmu has appointed Justice D.Y. Chandrachud as the executive chairman of the NALSA.

2) Krishnan Sankarasubramaniam

- Tamilnad Mercantile Bank (TMB) Ltd has announced the appointment of Krishnan Sankarasubramaniam as the Managing Director and CEO with effect for three years. His appointment was approved by the Reserve Bank of India.
- Tamilnad Mercantile Bank (TMB) is one of the oldest private sector banks with a history of 101 years, having been established in 1921 as Nadar Bank.

1) National Teachers' Day

- Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was a renowned Indian philosopher born in Tiruttani, Tamil Nadu, he became India's first Vice-President and second President. Since 1962 his birth anniversary has been celebrated as national Teachers' Day.
- He authored books such as The Philosophy of Rabindranath Tagore, The Reign of Religion in Contemporary Philosophy, Indian Philosophy, The Philosophy of the Upanishads, etc.
