INTERNATIONAL

1) Miss India Worldwide 2022

- The winner of the longest-running Indian beauty pageant outside of India, Miss India Worldwide 2022, was announced.
- Khushi Patel from United Kingdom crowned Miss India 2022. Shrutika Mane was named the second runner up, and Vaidehi Dongre from the US was named the first runner up.

2) Living Lands Charter

- All 54 Commonwealth members have agreed to voluntarily dedicate a 'living land' in their respective countries to future generations.
- Commonwealth was created in the early 1900s when nations began to secede from British Empire to ease the process of British decolonization.

3) UN Ocean Conference

- The 5-day UN Ocean Conference took off with the Governments of Kenya and Portugal being the co-hosts.
- It's objective is to find an international agreement on protecting the world's oceans, seas and marine resources.

NATIONAL

1) Report on India's GIG and Platform Economy

- Recently, NITI Aayog, launches report on India's GIG and Platform Economy.
- Gig workers are those engaged in livelihoods outside the traditional employer-employee arrangement.
- As per the report, about 47% of the gig work is in medium-skilled jobs, about 22% in high skilled, and about 31% in low-skilled jobs.

2) Uranium deposits

- Uranium deposits have been found in Rohil area of Sikar district of Rajasthan.
- One of its isotopes, uranium-235, is the only naturally occurring isotope capable of sustaining a nuclear fission reaction.
