ENVIRONMENT

1) Hasarius mumbai

- Researchers in Mumbai have made an exciting discovery of a new spider species, Hasarius mumbai.
- It belongs to the Salticidae family, also known as jumping spiders. These arachnids have unique hunting behaviors.
- They stalk and pounce on their prey, making them highly skilled hunters.

2) Flue gas de-sulfurisation

- Flue gas de-sulfurisation are crucial for controlling sulphur dioxide emissions and reducing air pollution.
- A report of Centre for Science and Environment highlights the low installation rate of FGD systems and the implications for emission norms compliance.
- According to the CSE analysis, only 5% of India's coal-fired power plants have installed FGD systems.

3) Energy Transition Index

- Energy Transition Index is published by World Economic Forum. In the report, India has secured the 67th position.
- Sweden has claimed the leading position, with Denmark, Norway, Finland, and Switzerland following closely behind.

SPORTS

1) Ladies European Tour

- Diksha Dagar, a golfer from Jhajjar, Haryana, secured her second Ladies European Tour (LET) title at the Czech Ladies Open.
- This victory marks her second individual win on the LET, and she now boasts nine top-10 finishes, with four of them achieved this season.

IMPORTANT DAYS

1) National Statistics Day

- National Statistics Day is celebrated every year on June 29th to honor the significant contributions made by Professor Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis.
- He was also known as the "father of Indian statistics".
- Theme of 2023: "Alignment of State Indicator Framework with National Indicator Framework for Monitoring Sustainable Development Goals".
- The first National Statistics Day was celebrated on June 29, 2007.

2) International Day of the Tropics

The International Day of the Tropics is observed annually on June 29 to acknowledge the extraordinary variety of the tropics while shedding more light on the distinctive challenges and opportunities that are faced by tropical areas.

3) National Insurance Awareness Day

- Every year, National Insurance Awareness Day is observed on June 29th as a reminder to people to check if all their insurance payments (or renewals) are up to date.
- As per the Economic Survey 2022-23 released on January 31, 2023, the Insurance penetration in India has risen from 2.7% (in 2000) to 4.2% (in 2020) and was 3.2% in 2021.
