#### **Exam Warriors**

- The updated edition of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's book, 'Exam Warriors' launched, a month before the CBSE board exams.
- The book has **new mantras** and a range of **interesting** activities to remain stress free before the exam.

#### **Strategic Energy Cooperation**

- Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, **Dharmendra** Pradhan held an introductory meeting virtually with US Secretary of Energy Jennifer Granholm.
- Both leaders agreed to revamp the India-US Strategic Energy Cooperation with focus on promoting clean energy with low-carbon pathways and accelerating green energy cooperation.
