NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Decline in India's Arms Imports

- According to a recent report by Stockholm International Peace Research Institute, India's arms imports came down by a third (about 33%) between 2011- 2015 and 2016-2020.
- India remains the second highest importer, only behind Saudi Arabia. Russia is the largest arms supplier to India.

Boris Johnson to visit India

- The Prime Minister of United Kingdom, Boris Johnson, is set to visit India.
- During the visit, the British government will look United towards boosting the Kingdom's opportunities and countering the influence of China in the Indo-Pacific region.

Project RE-HAB

- A pilot project RE-HAB (Reducing Elephant-Human Attacks using Bees) has been launched in Karnataka to mitigate human-elephant conflict.
- It is intended to create "bee fences" to thwart elephant attacks in human habitations using honeybees.

Hurun India Wealth Report, 2020

- The report identifies novel household category in India called the 'New Middle Class' which accounts for an average savings of Rs 20-lakh per annum.
- The report highlights that these households have major allocation towards the physical assets like primary residential property and automobiles.

"Chenab Bridge"

- The World's highest Bridge called the "Chenab Bridge" has completed a major milestone after the engineers completed the arch bottom of the bridge.
- The arch of the bridge across the river is being built by novel method of construction using the cable car.

Life Insurance Corporation of India is not being privatized

- The Central Government has informed the **Lok Sabha** that, the LIC is not being privatised.
- This information was provided by the government in a reply to a supplementary question during the Question Hour in Lok Sabha.

India - Finland Virtual Summit

- In the virtual summit, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Finland counterpart Sanna Marin will cover entire spectrum of the bilateral relationship.
- They will also exchange their views on the regional and global issues of the mutual interest.

BUSINESS & ECONOMY

Inflation Data

- The Office of the Economic Adviser, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade has released the Wholesale Price Index for the month of February, 2021.
- WPI increased for the second consecutive month to 4.17%. It measures the changes in the prices of goods sold and traded in bulk by wholesale businesses to other businesses.

"UPI-Help"

- National Payments Corporation of India has launched the "UPI-Help" on the BHIM UPI Application.
- UPI-Help will act as the grievance redressal mechanism on the BHIM application for the users. UPI is an instant real-time payment system which has been developed by NPCI.

ENVIRONMENT & GEOGRAPHY

Unscientific mining in Meghalaya

- The National Green Tribunal have established an oversight committee to prevent the unregulated and Unscientific mining in Meghalaya.
- The committee was established after the NGT observed that rat-hole mining is so often in Meghalaya despite the government has put ban on it.

Great Indian Bustards

- The **Supreme Court of India** has given its suggestion in the behalf of the **critically endangered Great Indian** Bustards after the number of birds falling dead due to collision with power lines is increasing over time.
- This bustard is found on Indian subcontinent.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

5G radio solution

- Nokia, announced that it has partnered with the Microsoft, Amazon web services and Google so as to develop a new cloud-based 5G radio solution.
- This solution will be developed with its radio access network (RNA) technology. RAN is the part of a mobile telecommunication system.

Mosquito protein - AEG12

- The researchers have found that, a mosquito protein called **AEG12** strongly inhibits the family of viruses which causes dengue, yellow fever, Zika and West
- They also noted that the protein also inhibits the coronaviruses. The researchers used the X-ray crystallography to solve structure of the protein.
