NATIONAL

1) India is set to receive cheetahs

- By end of 2022, India is set to receive cheetahs from South Africa and Namibia at Kuno Palpur wildlife sanctuary in Sheopur district of Madhya Pradesh.
- The Project is to translocate cheetahs is being implemented by Ministry of Environment with the help of Wildlife Institute of India.
- Cheetahs was declared extinct in India in 1952 due to over-hunting and loss of habitat.

2) Jal Jeevan Mission

- India has reached the milestone of providing tap water to 50 percent of rural households under Jal Jeevan Mission.
- Goa, Telangana, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, Puducherry and Haryana have already achieved 100 percent household connections.
- Jal Jeevan Mission was launched in 2019 by Ministry of Jal Shakti.

3) US becomes India's top trading partner

- As per the latest data from Ministry of Commerce, US was India's top trading partner in 2021-22, surpassing China.
- UAE was the third largest trading partner of India followed by Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Singapore.
- Bilateral trade between US and India stood at \$119.42 billion as against \$80.51 billion in 2020-21. India had a trade surplus with US.

4) Hypersonic technology

- Russia successfully test-fired Tsirkon hypersonic cruise missile from the Barents Sea.
- Hypersonic defines speed of about Mach 5 or at least at 1.6 km per second.
- Mach number describes an object's speed compared with speed of sound in air.

5) Pseudomonas Bacteria

- Recently, Scientists discovered Pseudomonas Bacteria in Antarctica.

SPORTS

1) Formula 1 Grand Prix De Monaco 2022

- The Red Bull racing driver Sergio Pérez (Mexican) has won the Formula 1 Grand Prix De Monaco 2022 with 25 points, held at Circuit de Monaco, Monaco, Europe.
- With this victory, Sergio Pérez becomes the first Mexican to win the Monaco Grand Prix, and the first North American to win it since Gilles Villeneuve in 1981.
