INTERNATIONAL

1) World Summit of Information Society 2022

- The Minister of Communications attended the opening ceremony of the World Summit of Information Society 2022 in Geneva, Switzerland, where India showcased its telecom prowess during multilateral & bilateral engagements.
- India has been a member of ITU, since 1869 and has been continuously participating, actively in the works, and activities of the Union.

NATIONAL

1) India and Canada have signed a MoU on climate change

- India and Canada have signed a memorandum of understanding to strengthen bilateral collaboration on climate change, environmental preservation, and conservation.
- On the sidelines of the Stockholm+50 summit, Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav and his Canadian colleague Steven Guilbeault signed a Memorandum of Understanding.
