COVAXIN neutralises the Double Mutant Strain of COVID

- The Indian Council of Medical Research announced that COVAXIN neutralises the Double Mutant Strain of COVID-19.
- The National Institute of Virology demonstrated the neutralisation potential of COVAXIN against the Brazil variant and UK variant.

India was elected to the three bodies of the United

- India was elected to the three bodies of the United Nations.
- They were the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, Executive Board of the UN Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women and the Executive Board of World Food Programme.

Crude oil production of India fell crude oil production of India fell

- Crude oil production of India fell to 30.5 million tonnes. It was 32.17 million tonnes in 2019-20. It's production fell by 5% in 2020-21 as compared to the previous year.
- The Oil and Natural Gas Corporation produced 2% less oil in 2020-21 as compared to 2019-20.

Central Government has extended the Insurance scheme

- The Central Government has extended the Insurance scheme under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package for Health workers fighting COVID-19 for a period of one year.
- The scheme provides an insurance cover of INR 50 Lakh to health workers fighting COVID-19.
