#### **NATIONAL**

## 1) Cheetahs introduced in Kuno National Park

- India brought five females and three male cheetahs from Namibia at Madhya Pradesh's Kuno National Park.
- The Kuno National Park being home to other cats like leopard and lions have abundant prey and grasslands to support cheetahs.
- The cheetah was officially declared extinct by the Indian government in 1952 due to issues of over-hunting, decimation of its relatively narrow prey base species and the loss of its grassland-forest habitat.

### **2) KRITAGYA 3.0**

- KRITAGYA 3.0 is a national level hackathon to promote speed breeding for crop improvement to ensure overall sustainability and resilience in crop production in India.
- It gives an opportunity to students / faculties / entrepreneurs / innovators and others to showcase their innovative approaches & technology solutions.

# 3) 'BLO e-Patrika'

- The Election Commission of India has released a new digital publication 'BLO e-Patrika' at an interactive session held with BLOs spread across the states in India.
- Over 350 BLOs joined the meeting via video-conferencing from the office of Chief Electoral Officers (CEO).

- Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya launched a 15-day blood donation drive on the occasion of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday.
- The blood donation drive is known as 'Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav' which will continue till 1st October 2022 which is National Voluntary Blood Donation Day.
