INTERNATIONAL

1) High Mobility Artillery Rocket System

- To Support Ukraine, USA has announced sending its advanced missile systems HIMARS to Ukraine.
- HIMARS is a long-range, mobile, precision artillery system developed by Lockheed Martin.

NATIONAL

1) Valmiki Tiger Reserve

- The forest department of Bihar has established an elephant rescue centre in Valmiki Tiger Reserve.
- The tiger reserve is located in the extreme north-eastern end along the international border with Nepal in western Champaran district, Bihar.

2) Radio frequency Identification

- Delhi airport has become the first Indian airport to introduce RFID-enabled tag to track check-in luggage.
- Bag tags will be called 'Bagg Trax'.
- RFID refers to a wireless system comprised of two components: tags and readers.

3) Caste-based Census

- Caste-based Census is the enumeration of people or households based on Caste identity to identify the actual demographic composition of different castes and their share of national assets.
- It was started in India during the British period and continued till 1931.
- In 1951, as a conscious policy decision, the caste-wise enumeration- other than Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes- was given up.

4) Akhil Bhartiya Ayurved Mahasammelan

- President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, inaugurated the 59th Maha Adhiveshan of the Akhil Bhartiya Ayurved Mahasammelan in Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh.
- Ayurveda means Science of Life in Sanskrit. The term 'pathy' is used to describe a variety of medical systems around the world.
