INTERNATIONAL

1) Sustainable Development Goals report 2022

- Sustainable Development Goals report 2022 is released by United Nations.

- SDGs Report 2022 is the only UN official report that monitors global progress on the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development using the latest available data and estimates.

2) Global Livability Index 2022

- Global Livability Index 2022 is released by Economist Intelligence Unit's (EIU).
- Index ranked 173 cities based on their livability or living conditions.
- Delhi has been ranked best liveable city in India, followed by Mumbai, Chennai, Ahmedabad and Bengaluru.
- Vienna is the most liveable city.

3) Eoscansor Cobrensis

- Eoscansor cobrensis is a 305-Million-Year-Old Fossil identified from an incomplete skeleton found in New Mexico (State in USA). It belonged to Varanopidae, an extinct family of reptiles that resembled monitor lizards.

NATIONAL

1) UNESCO Convention

- India has been chosen to participate in the 2022–2026 cycle of the UNESCO Convention for the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage, which was adopted in 2003.

- At the UNESCO headquarters in Paris, during the 9th General Assembly of the 2003 Convention, the Intergovernmental Committee elections were held.

1) Cyber VaultEdge insurance plan

1) R Dinesh

- R Dinesh, Executive Vice-Chairman of TVS Supply Chain Solutions, has been chosen as the Confederation of Indian Industry's President Designate for the years 2022–2023.

- He previously served as the Chairman of the National Committees on Logistics.

2) Amitabh Kant

- Former NITI Aayog CEO Amitabh Kant has been picked as India's new Sherpa for G-20.

- Sherpa is a personal representative of the leader of a member country at an international Summit meeting such as G8, G20 or Nuclear Security Summit.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS

1) 'Wall of former chief economists'

- Gita Gopinath became the first woman and second Indian to feature on the 'wall of former chief economists' of the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

- The first Indian to achieve the honour was Raghuram Rajan who was Chief Economist and Director of Research of IMF between 2003 and 2006.

OBITUARY

1) P. Gopinathan Nair

- Freedom fighter P. Gopinathan Nair has passed away at the age of 100. He was known for following Gandhian ideology in his life and was honoured with the Padma award.

- He had participated in the freedom struggle.

- He participated in the Quit India Movement of 1942 and had worked alongside Vinoba Bhave to promote Bhoodan and Gramdan movements.

2) Shinzo Abe

- Shinzo Abe, Former Japan's Prime Minister, who was shot at during an election campaign in western Japan's Nara city, has passed away.

- Abe, the country's longest-serving prime minister until he resigned in 2020
