New Development Bank issued a USD 1.5 billion benchmark bond

- New Development Bank of BRICS issued a USD 1.5 billion benchmark bond with 5 years of maturity. This is the 3rd USD benchmark bond offering of NDB in the international markets.
- It will use to provide COVID-19 Emergency Program Loans to the member countries.

HSBC India ties up with Google Pay and Visa

- HSBC India has partnered with Google Pay and Visa to provide a secured tokenization on its credit cards.
- Because of this partnership, contactless payments can be done by linking HSBC credit cards in Google Pay and it will help to **avoid physical contact** for payment.

RBI Cancelled the Licence of Bhagyodaya Friends Urban **Co-operative Bank**

• The RBI has cancelled the license of Bhagyodaya Friends Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, Maharashtra, as the bank doesn't have adequate capital to fund its depositors in full and as it did not comply with the various provisions of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.

India Ratings Reduced India's GDP Growth Forecast for FY22

- India Ratings and Research have reduced India's GDP growth forecast of FY22 to 10.1 per cent, from its earlier projection of 10.4 per cent.
- SBI Research also reduced India's growth forecast for FY22 to 10.4 per cent from 11 per cent of the earlier predictions.
