NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Biggest floating solar power plant

- The biggest floating solar power plant of India is to be set up at Ramagundam in Telangana.
- The capacity of the solar power plant is **100 MW**. The project is commissioned by **National Thermal Power Corporation**.

Rules of thermal power plants emission standards

- The Ministry of Environment, amended the rules of thermal power plants emission standards.
- The new rule has extended the deadline for the thermal power plants within 10 Kms of National Capital Region and in cities with more than ten lakh population to comply with the new emission norms by the end of 2022.

National Register for Driving Licenses

 The Ministry of Road Transport announced that the National Register for Driving Licenses is to be created. This is being done to remove duplication of driving licenses in the country. Most of the states are already on the SARATHI portal of National Informatics Centre. These states have been instructed to migrate to the newly created national register.

Indian Railways has achieved the highest ever electrification

- The Indian Railways has achieved the highest ever electrification of sections during 2020-21. It has covered 6,015 kilo metres of electrification in a single year.
- This is **37% higher** than that achieved in 2019-20. In the last seven years, the electrification of Indian Railways has increased by seven times.

Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation Limited

- The TRIFED, Ministry of Tribal Affairs and the Government of India have launched two interesting competitions for the tribal people.
- They are "Be the Brand Ambassador of Tribes India" and "Be a Friend of TRIBES INDIA" contest. The contests were launched in association with MyGov.in.

PM-KUSUM

- The first farm-based solar power plant under the Prime Minister's Kisan Urja Suraksha Evam Utthan Mahabhiyan scheme has come up in Jaipur with a provision for production of 17 lakh units of electricity every year.
- The PM-KUSUM scheme was to support installation of off-grid solar pumps in rural areas and reduce dependence on grid, in grid-connected areas.

Tamilisai launches COVID19 vaccine centre for women

 Puducherry Lt. Governor Tamilisai Soundararajan volunteered for vaccination at the Rajiv Gandhi Women and Children's Hospital to launch an exclusive vaccination centre for women at the hospital and provide a fillip to the vaccination program.

BUSINESS & ECONOMY

Harmonised System of Nomenclature

- The Ministry of Finance announced that the businesses with annual turn over of more than Rs 5 crores will have to furnish six-digit HSN code on their tax invoices.
- The businesses with an annual turn over of less than five crores of rupees have to furnish four-digit HSN code. Previously, the requirement was four digits and two digits respectively.

India's Merchandise Trade Deficit

- According to the data released by the government showed that India's trade deficit in goods widened to USD 14.11 billion in March 2021 from USD 9.98 billion during March 2020.
- India's merchandise exports in March 2021 were USD 34.0 billion as compared to USD 21.49 billion in March 2020, an increase of 58.23%.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

Covid-19 Reinfection

- A team of scientists from the Indian Council of Medical Research examined the cases of 1,300 individuals who had tested positive for the corona virus twice.
- It was found that 58 cases of the 1,300 individuals or 4.5% could be classified as **possible reinfections**. The first confirmed case was reported from Hong Kong.
