- In Soft Tennis, India's Tanushree Pandey has clinched the Silver Medal at the World Soft Tennis Championship at Jingshan in China.
- She faced a defeat against Chiang Min Yu of Chinese Taipei, in the Under 21 Women's Individual Singles final.
- Earlier, Tanushree triumphed over Japanese opponent, in a fiercely contested semifinal match.

## Wriddhiman Saha announces retirement from cricket

- Indian wicketkeeper-batter Wriddhiman Saha has announced his retirement from cricket, with the ongoing Ranji Trophy season being his last.
- Age and Career: The 40-year-old Bengal player debuted internationally in 2010 and has played 40 Tests and nine ODIs for India.
- IPL Participation: Saha has decided participate in the 2025 Indian Premier League (IPL) season and was not retained by Gujarat Titans (GT) ahead of the 2025 mega auction.
- Reputation: Known for his excellent wicketkeeping skills, Saha is often regarded as one of India's finest pure wicket-keepers in recent years.
- Central Contracts: Saha was released from the BCCI's Central Contracts in 2023 and has not returned to the Test squad since.
- IPL Journey: Saha is among the few players to have featured in every IPL season since the inaugural 2008 season.
- Franchises Played For: Throughout his IPL career, Saha has represented five teams – Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR), Chennai Super Kings (CSK), Punjab Kings (PBKS), Sunrisers Hyderabad (SRH), and Gujarat Titans (GT).

#### Harmeet Desai claims dual titles at WTT Feeder Caracas in Venezuela

- Dual Titles for Harmeet Desai: Indian table tennis player Harmeet Desai won both the Men's Singles and Mixed Doubles titles at the WTT Feeder Caracas in Venezuela.
- Mixed Doubles Victory: Desai, partnering with Krittwika Roy, won the Mixed Doubles final, narrowly defeating Cuba's Jorge Campos and Daniela Fonseca Carrazana with a score of 3-2.

## India bags 17 medals including four Gold at **Under-19 World Boxing Championships**

- India won a total of 17 medals at the Under-19 World Boxing Championships held in Colorado, USA.

- Squad Composition: The Indian team comprised 19 boxers—9 men and 10 women.
- Finalists: Twelve Indian boxers reached the finals, with every female boxer winning a medal.

- NCOE Contribution: The Sports Authority of India's National Center of Excellence (NCOE) Rohtak contributed to 10 medals, with eight of its athletes among the winners.
- NCOE Aurangabad's Contribution: Krisha Verma's gold medal was contributed by the NCOE Aurangabad.
- Future Aspirations: India aims to further strengthen its position in boxing, with hopes for the sport's inclusion in the Los Angeles 2028 Olympics.

## Moldova: President Maia Sandu re-elected for second term








## EAM S Jaishankar inaugurates new Consulate General of India in Brisbane, Australia
