Indian Coast Guard signs MoU for Marine Conservation

- The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with The Habitats Trust and HCL Foundation for marine conservation in New Delhi.
- The primary objective of this initiative is to implement critical conservation efforts, including the removal of ghost nets, mapping and classifying areas affected by ghost gear, and enhancing understanding to prioritize cleanup efforts.
- Under this MoU, surveys will be conducted ecologically sensitive regions to monitor and protect marine biodiversity.
- The ICG, Habitats Trust, and HCL Foundation will work together to involve coastal communities in conservation activities, fostering stewardship of marine ecosystems.

Indian Coast Guard (ICG):

- Established: 1st February 1977.
- Primary Role: The ICG is responsible for safeguarding India's maritime interests and enforcing maritime law, including anti-smuggling, anti-piracy, and environmental protection.
- Headquarters: New Delhi, India.
- Director General (DG): The position has been vacant since 18 August 2024. The current Additional Director General is S. Paramesh.

India's Dhanush Loganathan Wins Bronze at IWF **Junior World Championships 2024**

- Dhanush Loganathan won the bronze medal in the men's 55kg category at the IWF Junior World Weightlifting Championships 2024, held in Leon, Spain.
- The 17-year-old lifted a total of 231kg (107kg in snatch + 124kg in clean and jerk).

Achievements:

- Won a bronze medal in the total category (combined snatch and clean & jerk).
- Also secured a bronze medal in the snatch event.
- Finished 13th in the clean and jerk.

Gold and Silver Medalists:

- Gold: Vietnam's K Duong, with a total lift of 253kg (115kg in snatch + 140kg in clean and jerk).
- Silver: Japan's Kotaro Tomari, with a total lift of 247kg (108kg in snatch + 139kg in clean and jerk).
- Indian Contingent: India's team for the Junior World Championships includes three men and six women weightlifters. Payal (women's 45kg) and Panchami Sonowal (women's 49kg) also competed but did not secure medals.

Finance Ministry Notifies Direct Tax Vivad Se Vishwas **Scheme**, 2024

- The Union Finance Ministry notified the Direct Tax Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme, 2024, which will come into effect on October 1.
- **Purpose:** The scheme allows taxpayers to settle appeals, write petitions, and special leave petitions pending in the Supreme Court, high courts, and appellate tribunals as of the cutoff date of July 22.
- Operational Date: While the scheme's operational date has been announced, the final date for completion is yet to be determined.
- Settlement Process: Taxpayers with direct tax appeals pending can opt to settle by paying the full tax amount, thereby waiving any interest and penalties associated with the appeal.
- **Background:** The scheme was initially introduced in 2020 to facilitate the settlement of direct tax appeals pending until January 31, 2020, when 483,000 appeals were pending, involving Rs 4.96 trillion.
- Current Statistics: As of now, there are 544,000 appeals before the Commissioner of Income-Tax (Appeals), with the disputed amount rising to Rs 10.6 trillion.
- Transfer Pricing Issues: Transfer pricing remains a significant concern in tax disputes among multinationals, with provisions for secondary adjustment tax in such cases.

Air Marshal Amar Preet Singh appointed as next IAF chief

- Air Marshal Amar Preet Singh, who has more than 5,000 hours of flying experience, will be the next chief of the Indian Air Force, succeeding Air Chief Marshal Vivek Ram Chaudhari.
- Singh, currently serving as the Vice Chief of Air Staff, will take charge of the force on September 30.
- Experience: Over 5,000 flying hours; Vice Chief of Air Staff.
- **Service Tenure:** Commissioned in 1984, spanning nearly 40 years.
- Background: Alumnus of National Defence Academy, Defence Services Staff College, and National Defence College.
- Key Roles: Fighter squadron commander, MiG-29 upgrade lead, and project director for Tejas.
- Staff Positions: Air Defence Commander, Senior Air Staff Officer at Eastern Air Command.

Chief of the Indian Air Force (IAF) Overview:

- Around ₹2.5 lakh per month Salary: (excluding allowances).
- Selection: Senior-most Air Marshal, chosen based on experience and merit.
- **Tenure:** 3 years or until the age of 62, whichever comes first.














Kalikesh Narayan Singh Deo elected president of **NRAI**

Kalikesh Narayan Singh Deo has been elected as the president of the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI).

Background

- Former Role: Kalikesh is a former Member of Parliament from Odisha.
- Caretaker Position: He has been managing the NRAI's day-to-day operations since the position became vacant after Raninder Singh's resignation.

Context of Resignation

- Government Directive: The Sports Ministry issued a directive under the National Sports Code (NSC) limiting the tenure of heads of national sports federations (NSFs) to a maximum of 12 years.
- Raninder Singh's Tenure: Raninder Singh served as president from December 29, 2010, to December 29, 2022, exceeding the 12-year limit.
- Achievements During Caretaker Tenure: Kalikesh's leadership as caretaker, India won three bronze medals at the Paris Olympics, breaking a medal drought from the 2016 Rio and 2020 Tokyo Games.
- Tenure Details: Presidency Duration: Kalikesh will serve as president until 2025, coinciding with the next NRAI general body elections.

Atishi Takes Oath As Delhi Chief Minister, Youngest Leader To Hold Top Post

- Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader Atishi took oath as the chief minister of Delhi, replacing Arvind Kejriwal who resigned earlier.
- Saurabh Bharadwaj, Gopal Rai and Kailash Gahlot took oath as ministers, having retained their positions in the new government.
- Imran Hussain also took oath as a minister.
- Sultanpur Majra legislator Mukesh Ahlawat is the new face in the cabinet.
- The tenure of the Atishi government will be brief as the assembly polls in Delhi are due in February next year.
- Atishi, 43, was chosen as the leader of legislature party ahead of Kejriwal handing over his resignation to lieutenant governor Vinai Kumar Saxena.
- As a minister in Kejriwal's Cabinet, Atishi, with 14 portfolios including finance, education, and revenue, was amongst those holding the fort while he was in jail.
