

India Successfully Tests Agni-4 Ballistic **Missile: Key Points**

- India carried out a successful launch of the Intermediate Range Ballistic Missile (IRBM) Agni-4 from the Integrated Test Range at Chandipur, Odisha. The test validated all operational and technical parameters, confirming the missile's reliability and performance.
- Supervised by SFC: The launch was conducted under the aegis of the Strategic Forces Command (SFC), responsible for India's nuclear arsenal.
- Strengthening Defence: The test is seen as a significant milestone in enhancing India's nuclear deterrence and overall defence capabilities.
- Agni-Prime Test: India also successfully tested the new-generation Agni-Prime missile from Abdul Kalam Island, meeting all trial objectives.
- Nuclear-Capable Missiles: The Agni missile series, developed by DRDO, is a long-range, nuclear-capable surface-to-surface missile system designed to bolster India's strategic defence.

INS Tabar Participates in 22nd Indo-French Naval **Exercise VARUNA**

- The Indian Navy's frontline warship INS Tabar participated in the 22nd edition of the India-France bilateral naval exercise VARUNA, held in the Mediterranean Sea.
- Participation: The Indian Navy represented by INS Tabar, a shipborne helicopter, and the Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance (LRMR) aircraft P8I.
- French Participation: The French Navy represented by FS Provence, Submarine Suffren, Atlantique 2 aircraft, F20 fighter jets, MB339 fighters, and helicopters NH90 and Dauphin.
- Objective: VARUNA highlights the commitment of both navies to enhance interoperability and foster stronger maritime cooperation.
- History of VARUNA: The exercise, which began in 2001, aims to strengthen the India-France defence relationship and facilitate the exchange of best practices.
- Frequency: VARUNA is held annually, with each edition taking place in different maritime zones, including the Indian Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, and Mediterranean Sea.

- The Central Government has allocated ₹1,400 crore for research and development (R&D) and ₹10,000 crore for Production Linked Incentives (PLI) in the technical textiles sector.
- Focus on Innovation: Addressing a conference Bharat-Technical **Textiles** "Viksit for on Sustainable Growth and Development" in New Delhi, Union Minister of Textiles, Giriraj Singh, highlighted the government's emphasis on advancements in technical textiles.
- Growing Demand: The demand for technical textiles is increasing in sectors such as aerospace, defence, hygiene, and agriculture.
- Support for Students: The government has ₹50 lakh to support sanctioned students' innovations in this sector.
- PLI Impact: Over 40 industries are currently working under the PLI scheme, which is expected to be a major driver of employment generation by 2030.

Paris Paralympics: Praveen Kumar Wins Gold in Men's High Jump T64

- Indian athlete Praveen Kumar won the gold medal in the Men's High Jump T64 final at the Paris Paralympic Games, with a record leap of 2.08m, setting a new Area record.
- Medal Tally Update: India now ranks 14th in the medal standings with a total of 26 medals—6 gold, 9 silver, and 11 bronze.
- Athlete's Achievement: Praveen Kumar, who previously won a silver medal at the Tokyo Paralympics, bettered his performance with this gold.
- Podium Finish: Loccident Derek from the USA secured the silver medal, and Giyazov Temurbek of Uzbekistan won the bronze.

Jyoti Berwal Wins Gold at U20 World Wrestling **Championships**

- Gold Medal Victory: Jyoti Berwal secured a gold medal in the women's 76 kg freestyle category at the U20 World Championships in Pontevedra, Spain. She defeated Ukraine's Mariia Orlevych in the final without conceding a single point.
- Path to the Final: Jyoti advanced to the final by defeating opponents from Mongolia, China, and Turkey, showcasing her dominance throughout the tournament.
- **India's Consecutive Titles:** This marks India's second consecutive gold in the women's 76 kg category at the U20 World Championships, following Priya Malik's win in 2023.

Additional Medals:

- Nitika clinched a silver medal in the women's 62 kg freestyle category at the U20 World Championships in Pontevedra, Spain, losing to Ukrainian wrestler Iryna Bondar 1-4.




Surat Tops India's Air Quality Rankings: Key Highlights

- Swachh Vayu Survekshan Awards 2023: Surat (Gujarat) ranks first for air quality improvements among Indian cities with over 1 million population, followed by Jabalpur (Madhya Pradesh) and Agra (Uttar Pradesh).
- Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav and Rajasthan Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma presented the awards to the winning cities.

Category-wise Winners:

- Cities with a population between 300,000 to 1 million: Firozabad (Uttar Pradesh), Amravati (Maharashtra), and Jhansi (Uttar Pradesh).
- Cities with a population under 300,000: Raebareli (Uttar Pradesh), Nalgonda (Telangana), and Nalagarh (Himachal Pradesh).
- National Clean Air Programme (NCAP): Launched in 2019, the NCAP aims to reduce particulate pollution (PM10) by up to 40% by 2025-26. The programme covers 131 non-attainment cities.

Moeen Ali Retires from International Cricket

- England all-rounder Moeen Ali announced his retirement from international cricket in September 2024 after not being selected for the upcoming white-ball series against Australia.
- Moeen Ali, aged 37, stated that it was time to step aside and allow the next generation of cricketers to take over.
- International Debut: Moeen Ali made his debut for the England cricket team in 2014.

Career Stats:

- Tests: Played 68 matches, scored 2,914 runs and took 204 wickets.
- **ODIs:** Played 138 matches, scored 2,391 runs and took 87 wickets.

Himachal Pradesh Signs Pact with IMD for **Automatic Weather Stations**

- The Himachal Pradesh government signed an agreement with the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) to install 48 automatic weather stations for real-time weather data. This will enhance forecasting and preparedness, especially for agriculture and horticulture sectors.
- The network will be expanded to the block level in phases. Currently, 22 automatic weather stations are operational in the state.
- **Disaster Management:** The initiative will improve management of natural disasters like excessive rainfall, flash floods, snowfall, and cloudbursts by strengthening early warning systems.
- Partnership with AFD: The Himachal government has consensus with Agence Française reached a Development (AFD) for a ₹890 crore project focused on disaster and climate risk reduction, aimed at building a more resilient disaster management framework.
- Fund Utilization: The funds will be used to strengthen the Himachal Pradesh State Disaster Management Authority, District Disaster Management Authorities, and emergency operation centres at both state and district levels.














US Open: Aryna Sabalenka beats Jessica Pegula to win 3rd Grand Slam title

Aryna Sabalenka wins the US Open, securing her third Grand Slam title.

Paris Paralympics: Navdeep's medal upgraded to gold in Men's Javelin F41

• Navdeep's medal in Men's Javelin F41 upgraded to gold at the Paris Paralympics.

Initial Performance:

- Navdeep initially won silver with a personal best throw of 47.32 metres.
- The Iranian athlete, Beit Sayah Sadegh, initially finished first with a Paralympic record of 47.65 metres.

Disqualification:

- Beit Sayah Sadegh was disqualified for violating rule 8.1 of the World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations (Code of Conduct and Ethics).
- Rule 8.1 emphasizes maintaining integrity, ethics, and conduct in para athletics.

Final Results:

- Navdeep's medal was upgraded to gold.
- This is India's first-ever gold medal in the Men's Javelin F41 category at the Paralympics.
- India's overall medal tally increased to 29 (7 gold, 9 silver, 13 bronze).
