




#### India **Extends** First-ever Rupeedenominated Line of Credit to Mauritius

- India has extended a ₹487.60 crore rupeedenominated Line of Credit (LoC) to the Government of Mauritius for a water pipeline replacement project.
- Significance: This is the first-ever rupeedenominated Line of Credit under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS), marking a milestone in India's project financing initiatives.
- Project Scope: The project involves the replacement of approximately 100 kilometers of obsolete water pipelines in Mauritius.
- Financing Terms: The Line of Credit will be provided by the State Bank of India on concessional terms.

# Union Minister Jitendra Singh Unveils India's First Self-powered Indoor Air **Quality Monitor**

- Union Minister of State for Science and Technology (Independent Charge) Dr. Jitendra Singh unveiled Pavana Chitra, India's first selfpowered indoor air quality monitor, Thiruvananthapuram International Airport. It operates off-grid, powered by indoor solar cells developed by CSIR-NIIST.
- Indigenous Innovation: The indoor solar cells, crafted from locally available materials, reflect India's advancements in renewable technology and sustainability.
- Biotechnology Focus: While addressing SC/ST farmers and artisans at Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Biotechnology (RGCB), the Minister emphasized India's readiness to lead in the biotechnology sector, aligning with the country's Bio E3 policy aimed at fostering innovation.
- Science Capital of India: Dr. Jitendra Singh described Thiruvananthapuram as the "Science Capital of India," highlighting its role in driving scientific innovation.

#### Arjun Erigaisi Wins WR Chess Masters Cup

- India's Arjun Erigaisi has won the WR Chess Masters Cup after defeating Maxime Vachier-Lagrave in the finals at London.
- After two drawn classical games, Arjun kept his composure under time pressure and won with black in the tiebreaker.
- By winning this 16-player knockout tournament, Arjun is now leading the FIDE Circuit.
- He will next compete in the European Chess Club Cup, starting this Sunday in Serbia.
- WR Chess Masters Cup:
- The WR Chess Masters Cup is an international chess tournament featuring top players from around the world.
- Format: It is a 16-player knockout tournament, where players compete in classical games, with tiebreakers deciding the winner in case of draws.
- Tiebreaker Format: If classical games end in a draw, the match is decided by a rapid or blitz tiebreaker.
- Significance: The tournament is part of the FIDE Circuit, impacting the global rankings of chess players.






#### ISSF World Cup Final: Vivaan Kapoor Wins Silver in Trap Event

- In the ISSF World Cup Final held in New Delhi, Indian shooter Vivaan Kapoor won the silver medal in the Trap event after scoring 44 in the final.
- Gold and Bronze Medalists: Chinese shooter Ying Qi claimed the gold medal, while Tolga N. Tuncer from Turkey won the bronze with a score of 35.
- Bronze in Skeet Event: Indian shooter Anantjeet Singh Naruka bagged the bronze medal in the Skeet Final Shotgun event.
- Medal Tally: China topped the medal tally with 8 medals, including 5 gold and 3 bronze. India finished in 9th place, securing 4 medals, including 2 silver and 2 bronze.
- India performed impressively at the 2024 ISSF World Cup Final, with several shooters securing medals:
- Vivaan Kapoor won a silver medal in the Trap event, finishing with a score of 44, behind China's Ying Qi (47 points)
- Anant Jeet Singh Naruka claimed a bronze medal in Skeet shooting with a score of 43
- Akhil Sheoran took home a bronze medal in the 50m Rifle 3 Positions (3P) event, marking his first World Cup Final medal
- Sonam Uttam Maskar won a silver medal in the 10m Air Rifle event, securing India's first medal of the competition
- India's overall performance in this event included a total of four medals—two silver and two bronze

#### Gujarat govt sanctions Rs 3.14 for crore infrastructure projects

- The Gujarat government has approved Rs 3.14 crore for 53 infrastructure development projects under the Jayanti Mukhyamantri Shaheri Swarnim Yojana.
- Municipal Corporation has received Vadodara approval for Rs 2.78 crore to carry out 50 projects, while Jasdan Municipality has been allocated Rs 19.17 lakh for the construction of concrete roads.
- Additionally, Vijapur Municipality will receive Rs 17.43 lakh for projects including CC roads and paver block installations.
- The Swarnim Jayanti Mukhyamantri Shaheri Vikas Yojana, initiated in 2010 by then Chief Minister Prime Minister Narendra Modi, focuses on improving basic amenities in private societies.
- The scheme operates on a 70:20:10 funding model, where the state government provides 70 per cent of the funding, while private societies contribute 20 per cent, and local bodies contribute 10 per cent.


### RBI bars Navi Finserv, DMI Finance and 2 other NBFCs from loan sanction, disbursal

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has banned Asirvad Micro Finance, Arohan Financial Services, DMI Finance, and Navi Finserv from sanctioning and disbursing loans due to pricing concerns.
- Effective Date: The business restrictions on these non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) will take effect on October 21, 2024.

#### **Company Backgrounds:**

- Navi Finsery: Founded by Flipkart co-founder Sachin Bansal after he left the e-commerce company.
- Asirvad Micro Finance: A subsidiary of Manappuram Finance.
- Reason for Action: The RBI's decision is based on material supervisory concerns related to the Pricing Policy of these companies, specifically:
- Excessive Weighted Average Lending Rate (WALR).
- High Interest Spread over their cost of funds.














#### Sanskrit scholar Vasant Anant Gadgil passes away at 94 in Pune
