
UAE Tops Global Rankings in Sustainable Development and Economic Innovation

It also ranks fourth globally in Economic Performance and leads the Arab world in Human Development, Education Systems, and Gender Equality indices.
- Sustainable Development: The UAE's success in meeting Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) is attributed to high rates of supervised medical care, universal access to basic services, and advanced civil registration systems.
- Governance Model: The UAE's governance emphasizes technological innovation, human rights, and infrastructure development, aligning with the 'We the UAE 2031' vision for sustainable growth and global cooperation.








Development Group Commits Billion to Combat Land Degradation by 2030

- The Arab Coordination Group (ACG) has pledged \$10 billion to address land degradation, desertification, and drought by 2030, announced at the UN Convention to Combat Desertification's COP16 in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.
- Focus Areas: The initiative targets restoring degraded lands and improving climate resilience in regions such as West Asia, North Africa, and the Sahel.
- Past Commitments: Previous ACG commitments include \$50 billion for African infrastructure (November 2023), \$24 billion for climate finance (COP27, 2022), and \$10 billion for food security (June 2022).
- Strategic Goals: The funds will support sustainable land management, biodiversity conservation, and livelihood preservation through innovative financing and partnerships.
- About ACG: The Arab Coordination Group is an alliance of 10 major development finance institutions, including the Islamic Development Bank and the OPEC Fund for International Development, focused on economic and social development in emerging markets.








Scottish Artist Jasleen Kaur Wins Turner **Prize 2024**

- Scottish artist Jasleen Kaur won the prestigious Turner Prize, marking the award's 40th anniversary. The prize, established in 1984, honors British artists for exceptional exhibitions or projects and carries a cash reward of £25,000.
- Winning Work: Kaur was recognized for her exhibition Alter-Altar, featuring a vintage red Ford Escort covered with a crocheted doily, worship bells, family photos, and soundtracks reflecting her family history and migrant upbringing.
- Ceremony: The announcement was made at Tate Britain in London, where Kaur triumphed over finalists Pio Abad, Claudette Johnson, and Delaine Le Bas.
- Jury Remarks: The jury praised her use of sound and sculpture to evoke themes of family memory and community struggles.
- Cultural Significance: Born in Glasgow to a family of Indian descent, Kaur's work draws on her Punjabi heritage and her family's migration to Scotland after Partition.
- Previous Winners: Past Turner Prize winners include Anish Kapoor, Damien Hirst, Steve McQueen, and last year's winner, Jesse Darling.

- Brian Thompson, CEO of United Healthcare (UHC) since April 2021, led the healthcare arm of UnitedHealth Group, ranked fifth on the Fortune 500 list.
- UHC is the largest health insurance company in the U.S., with annual revenues of \$281 billion and over 140,000 employees, including many in India handling back-office, technology, and strategy roles.
- UHC provides private health insurance primarily through employers and offers plans under government programs for senior citizens and low-income individuals.

Justice Manmohan Sworn in as Supreme **Court Judge**

- Chief Justice of India (CJI) Sanjiv Khanna administered the oath of office to Justice Manmohan, former Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court, as a Supreme Court judge.
- Judicial Strength: With this appointment, the Supreme Court now has 33 judges against its sanctioned strength of 34.
- Collegium Recommendation: The Supreme Court Collegium recommended Justice Manmohan's elevation on November 28, 2024, and the Centre cleared the appointment on December 3, 2024.
- Judicial Career: He became an additional judge of the Delhi High Court on March 13, 2008, and a permanent judge on December 17, 2009. He served as acting Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court on November 9, 2023, and Chief Justice from September 29, 2024.
- Supreme Court Judge
- Eligibility Criteria:
- Must be a citizen of India.
- Should have served as a High Court judge for at least five years or an advocate in a High Court for at least ten years, or be a distinguished jurist in the opinion of the President.
- Appointment:
- Appointed by the President of India on the recommendation of the Supreme Court Collegium.
- Tenure:
- Holds office until the age of 65.
- Can resign by submitting a resignation to the President.
- Can be removed through a process of impeachment by Parliament.
- Composition:
- The sanctioned strength of the Supreme Court is 34 judges, including the Chief Justice of India (CJI).
- Independence:
- Judges' salaries and allowances are charged on the Consolidated Fund of India and cannot be reduced during their tenure.
- Removal is based on proven misbehavior or incapacity.
- Chief Justice of India:
- The senior-most judge of the Supreme Court is typically appointed as the Chief Justice of India.

Arunachal Pradesh Government and Indian Army Sign MoA for Tawang Museum Maintenance

- Arunachal Pradesh government and the Indian Army signed an MoA for the maintenance of the Major Ralengnao Bob Khathing Museum of Valor in Tawang.
- The MoA was signed by Tawang Deputy Commissioner Kangki Darang and Brigadier V S Rajput of the 190 Mountain Brigade in the presence of Chief Minister Pema Khandu.
- Responsibility: Under the agreement, the Indian Army will fully oversee the management and upkeep of the museum.
- Significance: The museum honors Major Ralengnao Bob Khathing, reflecting efforts to integrate Tawang into India, aligning with Sardar Patel's vision of a unified nation.
- Arunachal Pradesh
- Capital: Itanagar
- Formation: Gained statehood on 20th February 1987
- Largest District: Changlang (area-wise)
- Borders: Assam, Nagaland, Bhutan, China, and Myanmar
- Geographical Significance:
- Known as the "Land of the Rising Sun" in India.
- Contains significant mountain ranges like the Himalayas.
- Major rivers: Brahmaputra (called Siang in Arunachal), Lohit, Subansiri.
- Historical and Cultural Significance:
- Formerly part of the North-East Frontier Agency (NEFA).
- Tawang is an important Buddhist site with the famous Tawang Monastery, the largest monastery in India.
- Diverse tribal population, with more than 26 major tribes like Nyishi, Apatani, and Monpa.
- Flora and Fauna:
- National Parks: Namdapha National Park, Mouling National Park.
- Significant wildlife species: Red Panda, Snow Leopard, and Arunachal Macaque.
- Strategic Importance:
- Shares a long and disputed border with China, referred to as the McMahon Line.
- Strategically significant for India's defense.
- Important Facts:
- Arunachal Pradesh is India's largest state in the Northeast by area.
- Home to the first village of India, Kaho, in Anjaw district.
- Receives the first sunrise in India.








IESA and ELCIA Collaborate to Boost Sensor **Manufacturing in India**
