# Maharaja Suheldev

- The **Prime Minister** has laid the foundation stone of Maharaia Suheldev memorial and the development work of Chittaura lake in Uttar Pradesh.
- He was the erstwhile ruler of Shravasti in Uttar Pradesh's (UP) Bahraich district, who ruled in the 11<sup>th</sup> century.

## Indian Sign Language

- The ministry of **Social Justice and Empowerment** will release the third edition of the Indian Sign Language (ISL) Dictionary.
- It will include the academic, legal, medical technical, administrative and agricultural terms in it.

### 'e-Chhawani'

Defence Minister Rainath Singh launched an online portal 'e-Chhawani' and mobile app, to facilitate 'ease of living' and 'ease of doing' for the residents of the Cantonment Boards across the country.

## Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala

- Nigeria's Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala was appointed as Director-General of the World Trade Organisation, the leading international trade body.
- She is the **first African** official and the **first woman** to hold the position.

### Justice Rama Jois

- Former Governor of Bihar and Jharkhand, Justice (Retd.) M. Rama Jois has passed away.
- He was also a senior advocate in the Supreme Court of India.
